INSTRUCTIONS FOR SPECIAL USE PERMIT WAIVER

- 1. Apply to the Building Office for Town of Greece Change of Business Information Form & Permit.
- 2. If Plan Review staff is of the opinion that this business **may** qualify for a Special Use Permit waiver from the Town Board, all of the information is forwarded to the staff adviser to the Town Board.
- 3. Staff Adviser to the Town Board provides the business representative a copy of the Town Board resolution stipulations to review and determine if they are willing to accept the conditions of the resolution.
- 4. If the business representative accepts the previous conditions, they should prepare and submit to the Department of Development Services staff the following items as part of the waiver application:
 - a. Completed Special Use Permit Waiver Request Form, signed and notarized by the applicant or by the owner.
 - b. A written request from an applicant to the Town Board to waive requirements that a special use permit be obtained per Chapter 211 of the Code of the Town of Greece, New York (the town's zoning ordinance).
 - c. If the applicant does not own the subject property, proof that the applicant has authority to apply as agent for the owner(s). Proof may be in the form of a signed purchase offer or lease agreement, or a letter of authorization that is signed by the owner(s).
 - d. Fill out the attached description of the proposed operation.
- 5. The application fee. **This fee is nonrefundable.** Checks must be made payable to "Town of Greece." However, if the waiver is not granted, this fee may be applied to a request for a Special Use Permit from the Town Board. In this case, the balance of the Town Board Special Use Permit fee is owed by the applicant, along with a completed special use permit application package.
- 6. The Building Inspector or the Fire Marshal may require plans that are more detailed than what the Town Board requires. Contact the Director of Technical Services (723-2308) to find out what additional plans, inspections, and fees may be required.
