- 1. Authorization to make various adjustments and transfers to the 2023 budget (list attached).
- 2. Authorization to enter into an agreement for a performance by Nik and the Nice Guys on Tuesday, July 4, 2023.
- 3. Authorization for the Police Department to trade in in nine (9) upper rifle receivers that are no longer viable for use to Amchar Wholesale at \$125 each for a total of \$1125 in credit.
- 4. Authorization for the Police Department to trade in eighteen (18) Trijicon Advanced Combat Optical Gunsights that are no longer viable for use to Amchar Wholesale at \$100 each for a total of \$1800 in credit.
- 5. Authorization to accept a Letter of Credit from Fallmarc Development, LLC in the amount of \$963,178 for Stonewood Estates

10. Authorization for the Supervisor to enter into an agreement with Wendel Architects & Engineers for engineering services related to the construction of a Solar Facility located on town owned property.
11. Authorization to extend the following contracts for an additional year with no changes in pricing and contract terms:
