6:15 p.m. - Public hearing to consider the request submitted by Wiser Time, Inc. for a special use permit to operate a group instruction facility, to be known as Pinots Pallete, at 2544-B Ridgeway Avenue, and furthermore, consideration of a request to waive the 30-day notification and comment period on an application to the New York State Liquor Authority for a liquor license, requested by Wiser Time, Inc.

- 1. Issuance of a negative declaration, indicating no significant adverse environmental impact, for the coordinated environmental review of the Town's proposed replacement of the Braddock Bay Marina seawall (an Unlisted Action).

6. Authorization for the Supervisor to enter into a contract with ROC Memorials and Monuments for design and construction services for the Police Memorial Site on Town Hall Campus.
7. Authorization to set a bid date of December 4, 2018 at 3:00 p.m. for eight eziQC contracts.
8. Authorization to amend the Lease Agreement for the Barnard Crossing library Branch at 2808 Dewey Avenue in order to extend the original lease term with no increase to rent payments. Further, authorization for the Supervisor to execute any necessary documentation.
9. Authorization to enter into various agreements (list attached) for programs associated with the operation of the Greece Community and Senior Center; further authorization for the Supervisor to execute said agreements.
