- 2. Waiver of the requirements for a new special use permit to operate an existing day care facility, known as Doodle Bugs Children Center, on property located at 1700 English Road, requested by DB-1700 English LLC.
- 3. Authorization to enter into an intermunicipal agreement with Monroe County for GIS map services and data sharing.

Law enforcement agencies across New York State have expressed public safety concerns regarding these reforms. The Town Board voices its strong opposition to this legislation.
