6:05 p.m. Public hearing for consideration of proposed amendments to the Town’s Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) 2019 Annual Action Plan to allocate and reallocate additional supplemental funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD), as authorized by the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act.

- 1. Authorization to make various adjustments and transfers to the 2021 budget (list attached).
- 2. Authorization to enter into various agreements for programs associated with the operation of the Greece Community and Senior Center.
- 3. Authorization to accept a grant from the Rochester Area Community Foundation in the amount of \$20,000 for Trail Improvements and authorization for the Supervisor to execute all necessary documents.
- 4. Authorization for the Greece Town Court to apply for a JCAP Grant in the 2020-2021 Grant Cycle up to \$30,000.
- 5. Acceptance of a letter of credit from Forest Creek Equity Corp in the amount of \$259,930.80 for site work at Regency Park section 4.
- 6. Authorization to utilize \$5,750 in NYS Pedestrian Safety grant funding awarded to the Police Department by the New York State’s Highway Safety Program. The grant period is from 10/1/2021-9/30/2022.

7. Authorization to purchase a Rubber-tracked skid-steer and a tilting flatbed trailer off of the Sourcewell bid contract for the Department of Public Works.
8. Authorization to accept a New York State Multi-Modal Transportation Capital Program grant in the amount of \$50,000.
9. Authorization for the Supervisor or his designee to execute any and all documentation necessary to confirm the Town's compliance with equal opportunity programs, and further, confirmation of adoption of Title VI non-discrimination and equal opportunity policies and plans.
10. Authorization to appoint Michael McCann to the full time position of Maintenance Mechanic II, effective July 24, 2021.
11. Authorization to create one full time Senior Library Assistant and authorization to appoint Jenna Wygal to the full time position of Senior Library Assistant effective July 19, 2021.
12. Resolution of Intent to become Lead Agency in the Coordinate Environmental Review of the Li-Cycle North American Hub recycling facility proposed to be located within Eastman Business Park, generally south of Ridgeway Avenue and east of Lee Road, and further directing staff to commence such review by providing written notice to involved agencies as required by the State Environmental Quality Review regulations.
13. Resolution of Intent to become Lead Agency in the Coordinate Environmental Review of the Braddock Bay Navigation Channel project (project # MO-99) awarded to the town through the Governor's Resiliency and Economic Development Initiative (REDI) program, and further directing staff to commence such review by providing written notice to involved agencies as required by the State Environmental Quality Review regulations.

14. Authorization to abolish one full time Receptionist in the library and to create one full time Principal Library Clerk in the Library; furthermore authorization to appoint Ann Robach to the provisional full time position of Principal Library Clerk effective July 24, 2021.
15. Authorization to enter into an agreement with Nothnagle Drilling, Inc. for the installation of geothermal test wells. Further, authorization for the Supervisor to execute all necessary documentation.
