Supervisor Reilich and Town Board members awarded one proclamation to Wood Kettle Brewing owners, Joey Baldwin, Bruce Lish and Tanner Kartes, recognizing the outstanding awards their business has received. Wood Kettle Brewing is located on the corner of Manitou Road and Latta Road and has been in business since December of 2017. The company has brewed approximately 70 unique beers in five years. One particular beer, named "Brother Bear Brown Ale", won the 2022 Gold Medal in the American Brown Ale category, and also won the 2022 Governor's Cup for "Best in Show", being the highest honor awarded in a beer competition. This year, the team entered the NYS Brewer's Association Craft Beer Competition and their "Pearl to the Pine Weizenbock", brewed in collaboration with Nine Spot Brewing, won the Gold Medal in the Wheat Beer Category and a Gold Medal for Best Collaborative Beer at the show.
