PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Supervisor Reilich called upon Councilman Mike Barry to lead the Town Board in the Pledge of Allegiance. Reverend William Coffas of Our Mother of Sorrows Church provided the invocation.

Supervisor Reilich then provided his monthly update on significant Town projects and programs for the residents of the Town of Greece as follows:

NEW BUSINESSES

The Town Board and I were happy to host a ribbon cutting for My Wine and Cheese Bar. They are located at 3208 Latta Road – across from Wegmans in the Plaza with Abbots. They offering wonderful pairings and we all wish owner Michele Suhr much success.

RECRUITING ON THE ROAD

Last week we hosted the County's Recruiting on the Road Job Fair here at Town Hall. Over 25 businesses featuring over 200 jobs participated.

FLU CLINICS

We continue to host Flu Clinics throughout the months of September, October and November at Greece Town Hall. Our next scheduled flu clinic is scheduled for Friday, November 12th from 9:00 AM until noon. They anticipate a very busy flu season and I'd encourage our residents to take advantage of this service.

SMALL BUSINESS PROCLAMATION

As a former small businessman myself, the Town Board and I know the importance of supporting small businesses as they are the backbone of our community. Today we have put forth our Proclamation that officially encourages our residents to shop locally on Small Business Saturday. This year Small Business Saturday is on November 30th. We have so many Greece residents and own and operate their small businesses in town and this proclamation confirms our support of their endeavors.

BLUE HELP

The Town of Greece was the official location for the New York State Blue HELP walk. Blue HELP is an organization that recognizes the need and provides assistance and education surrounding Police Suicide Awareness. More police officers lost their lives to suicide than are killed in active duty

GREENLIGHT

We are happy to report that Greenlight continues to expand in the Town of Greece. Many installation areas have been completed or are in progress. If you would like to receive a "neighborhood awareness package" to help get the word out in your neighborhood – you should contact Greenlight directly for assistance. Again, we are glad to be able to provide another option to our residents.

HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE EVENT

On Saturday, October 12th we hosted the Household Hazardous Waste event at our DPW facility. Hundreds of residents took advantage of this convenient location to drop off their hazardous waste without having to travel to the County Ecopark. The event was once again, very popular and we will let residents know when we schedule another event.

COMPTROLLER REPORT

I wanted to share with residents that the Town of Greece received the results of the NYS Comptrollers Fiscal Stress Monitoring Audit.

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The Town was informed by Comptroller DiNapoli that the Town of Greece has scored a 1.7 on the Fiscal Stress Monitoring System. This score is listed as "No Designation" which is the best designation that you can receive. This information should serve as an indicator to the Greece taxpayers that the Town is fiscally sound.

The Town Board and I want all of our residents to be aware that year after year we have increased amenities, made improvements to our infrastructure, increased our commitment to public safety and have done all of this while lowering our tax rate. The Comptroller's scoring is proof that our careful budgeting and efforts toward decreasing town debt has allowed us to achieve fiscal stability.

PROCLAMATIONS, ADDITIONS/DELETIONS TO AGENDA

Supervisor Reilich along with the Town Board awarded one proclamation to Erik Ervay honoring his achievement of reaching the rank of Eagle Scout in Troop #240. Erik attained the rank of Eagle Scout through his efforts towards a Habitat Improvement Program at Braddock Bay Park. He worked with local companies to secure donations of 88 plants, shrubs and trees for his project. In addition, he also coordinated three (3) food drives to benefit the Greece Food Shelf.

2. Wherever this resolution refers to a specific applicant, developer, or operator, it shall be construed to include successors and assigns.
3. Wherever this resolution refers to a specific public official, agency, or regulation it shall be construed to include any succeeding authority.

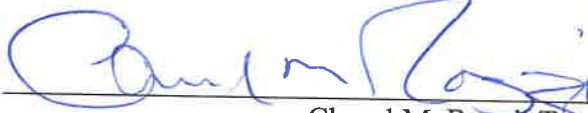
