The Resolution to be considered is as follows:

Resolution

RESOLVED, that pursuant to Section 176(11-c) of the Town Law, the Board of Fire Commissioners of the Barnard Fire District does hereby determine that in order to protect the residents of the Barnard Fire District, it is in the public interest of the residents of the Fire District to:

1. *Employ a paid fire chief of the fire district;*
2. *Provide for the powers and duties of the paid chief,*
3. *Comply with the certifications, education, training, appointment requirements and other qualifications required by the laws of the New York State for the appointment of an individual to this position.*
3. *Determine the chain of command in the fire district as between volunteer and paid officers and firefighters;*
4. *Determine that the paid chief shall have charge of apparatus and other equipment;*
5. *Determine that the paid and volunteer firefighters and officers of the fire department shall act under the orders and control of such paid fire chief;*
6. *Establish rules and regulations which set out the above determinations;*
7. *The salary of the paid chief to be employed will range between \$115,000 and \$130,000 per year depending upon the candidate's experience and qualifications.*
8. *Determine and approve such other terms and conditions for the employment of a paid fire chief as the board may determine are necessary.*
